

Criminal Injuries Compensation Appeals

1. the appellant serve the notice of appeal and a copy of these orders on the respondent;
2. no later than 21 days after service on the respondent, the respondent file and serve on the appellant a notice of intention to appear;
3. the appellant be at liberty to list the appeal for a hearing of [] hours upon compliance with paragraph 1;
4. no later than 21 days prior to the hearing, the appellant file and serve on the respondent and the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of the Attorney General a book of documents in addition to those provided to the Assessor on which the appellant intends to rely;
5. no later than 14 days prior to the date of the hearing, the respondent file and serve on the appellant and the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of the Attorney General a book of documents in addition to those provided to the Assessor on which the respondent intends to rely;
6. the [party] file and serve on the [party] a notice to produce [document];
7. the hearing fee for the appeal be paid within 7 days of today's date;
8. the costs of the hearing be in the appeal.
